



2010 Art Bike Competition Participant Registration Form and Rules

Rules

- Only one bike per participant will be judged.
- Decorated bike must be usable for riding.
- Decorations may be impermanent, that is, tempera paint, magnets, etc.
- Bike decorations should be tasteful and appropriate. The Art Bike Competition is in coordination with the Noble Street Festival—a family event.
- Bikes will be judged on the following criteria: Originality, Execution, and Creative use of materials.
- Before registering, please review the mandatory requirements for participants:
- April 5: Registration forms due to the Spirit of Anniston (no registration after this date)
- April 10: Decorated bikes must be brought downtown for judging at 10 am (exact location to be determined). Participants must leave bikes with The Spirit of Anniston for display purposes in downtown windows from April 12 – April 19; some may be displayed in medians on day of Festival (April 17).
- April 17: Participants are encouraged (though not required) to participate in the Art Bike Parade at The 2010 Noble Street Festival.
